INTRODUCTION

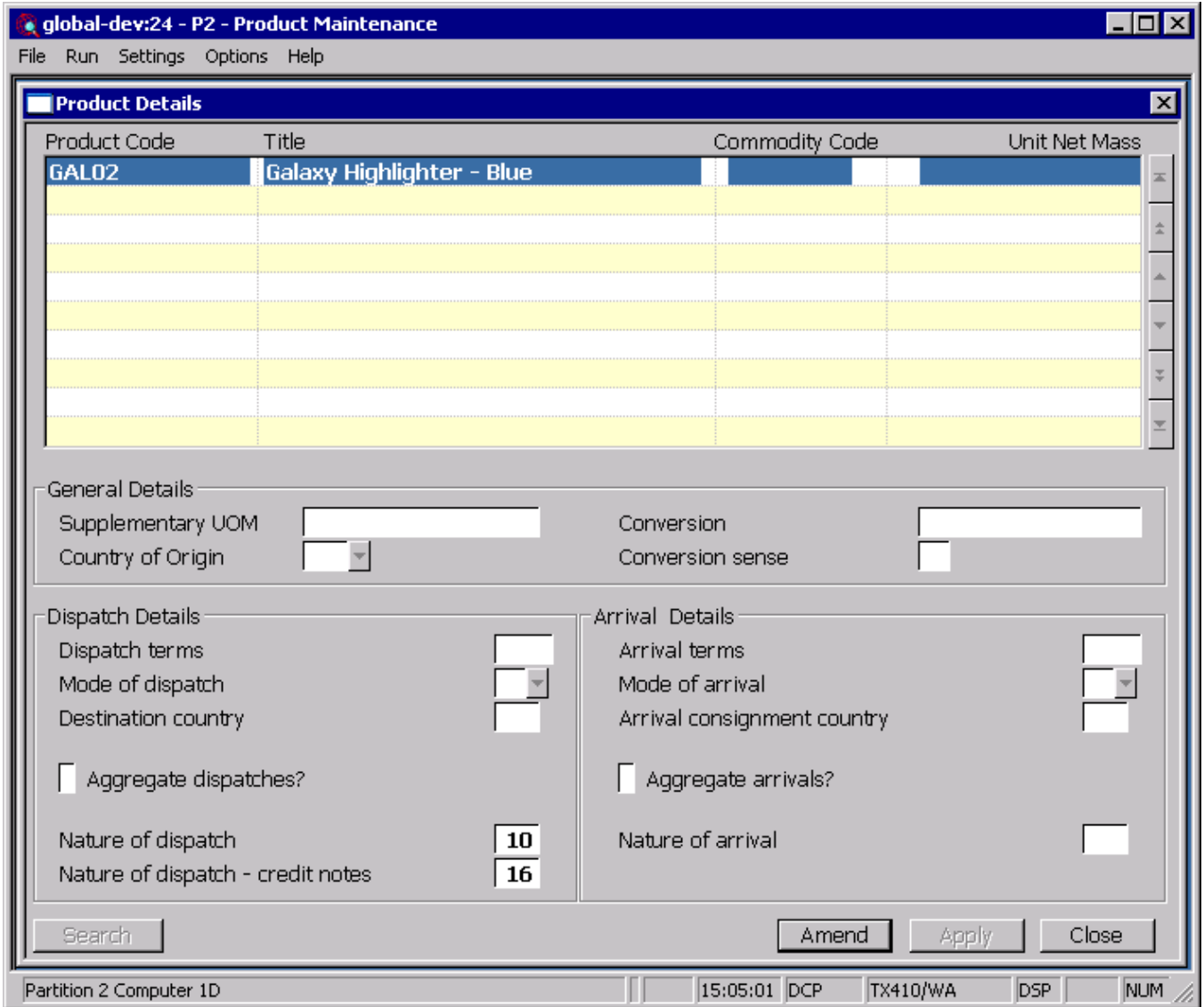
This service pack extends Intrastat to provide new system and product defaults that allow the Nature of dispatch to be defaulted differently for invoices and credit notes.

The changes extend the System Defaults and Product Details to allow a specific Nature of dispatch code to be entered for S.O.P. Credit Notes.

Note: The account defaults do not allow for separate Nature of dispatch and Nature of arrival codes and as such, the single Nature of transaction prompt will not be changed.

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Product Details Window

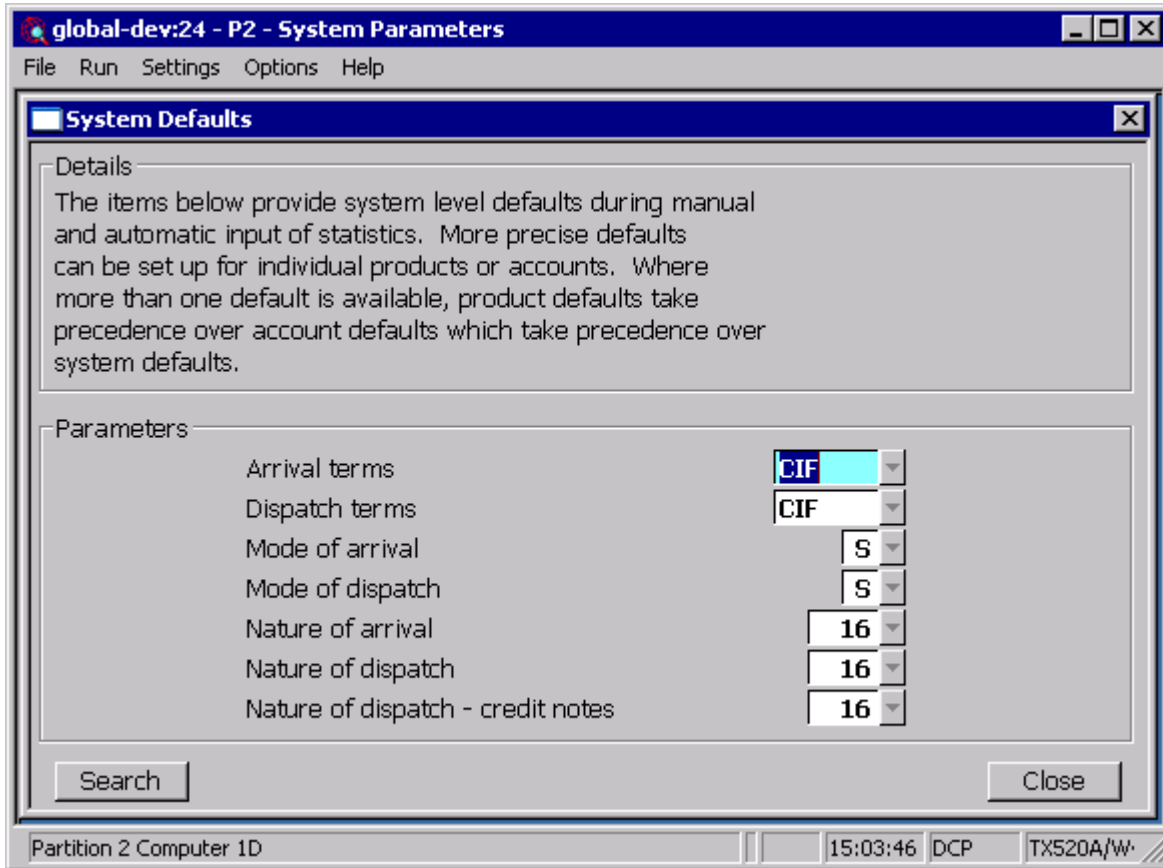


Nature of dispatch – credit notes

The code of the ‘nature of transaction’ for dispatches of this product recorded via (S.O.P.) credit notes. Leave as zero if it cannot be sensibly defaulted. This is a two digit code, details of which are provided in the ICN. Press the search button to display information about valid codes. If you enter this code, it must consist of two digits, each digit having a specific meaning.
