INTRODUCTION

The requirement is to provide the ability to specify free format text to be included in the email text generated when DL statements are delivered via email.

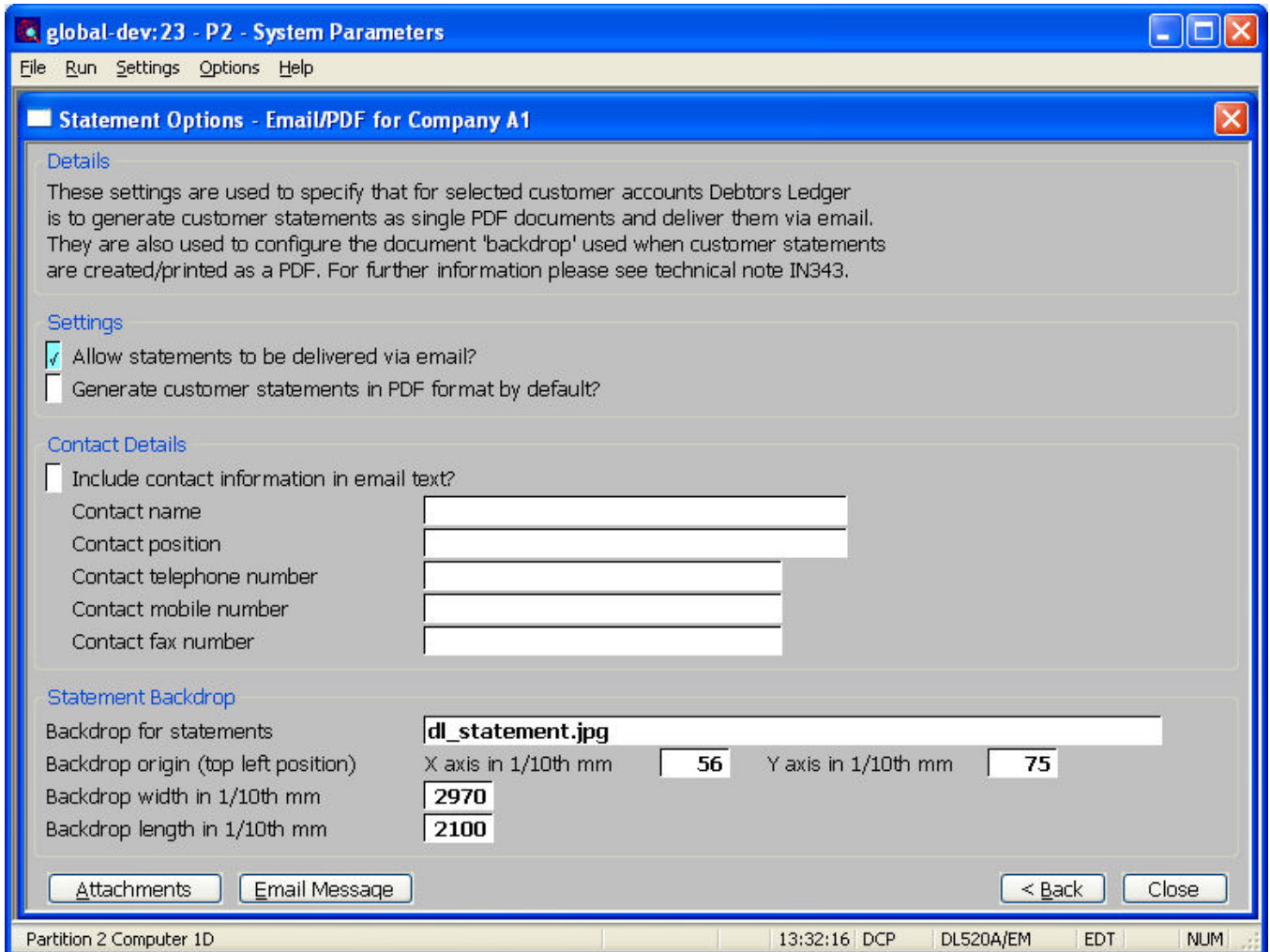
A new option labelled 'Include message in email?' has been added to the (DL) Statement Print and Statement for Customer windows. When enabled up to 3 lines (70 characters each) of user defined text is included in the body of the emails generated when statements are delivered via email.

A new button labelled 'Email Message' has been added to the (DL) Statement Print and Statement for Customer windows. When pressed a new window is displayed which allows the user to enter up to 3 lines (70 characters each) of text to be included in the body of the email generated when statements are delivered via email.

A new button labelled 'Email Message' has been added to the DL Statement Options - Email/PDF window. When pressed a new window is displayed which allows the user to set up to 3 lines (70 characters each) of text to be used as a default for the message which is included in the body of the email generated when statements are delivered via email.

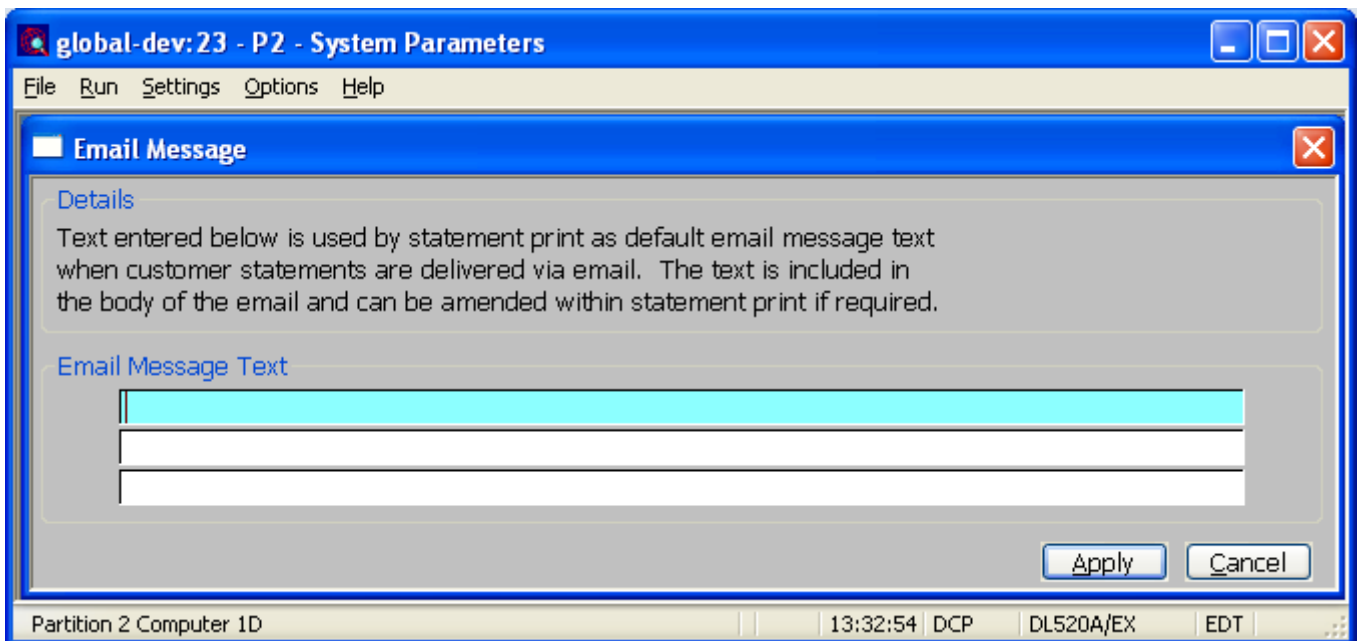
DL Parameters – Statement Options – Email/PDF

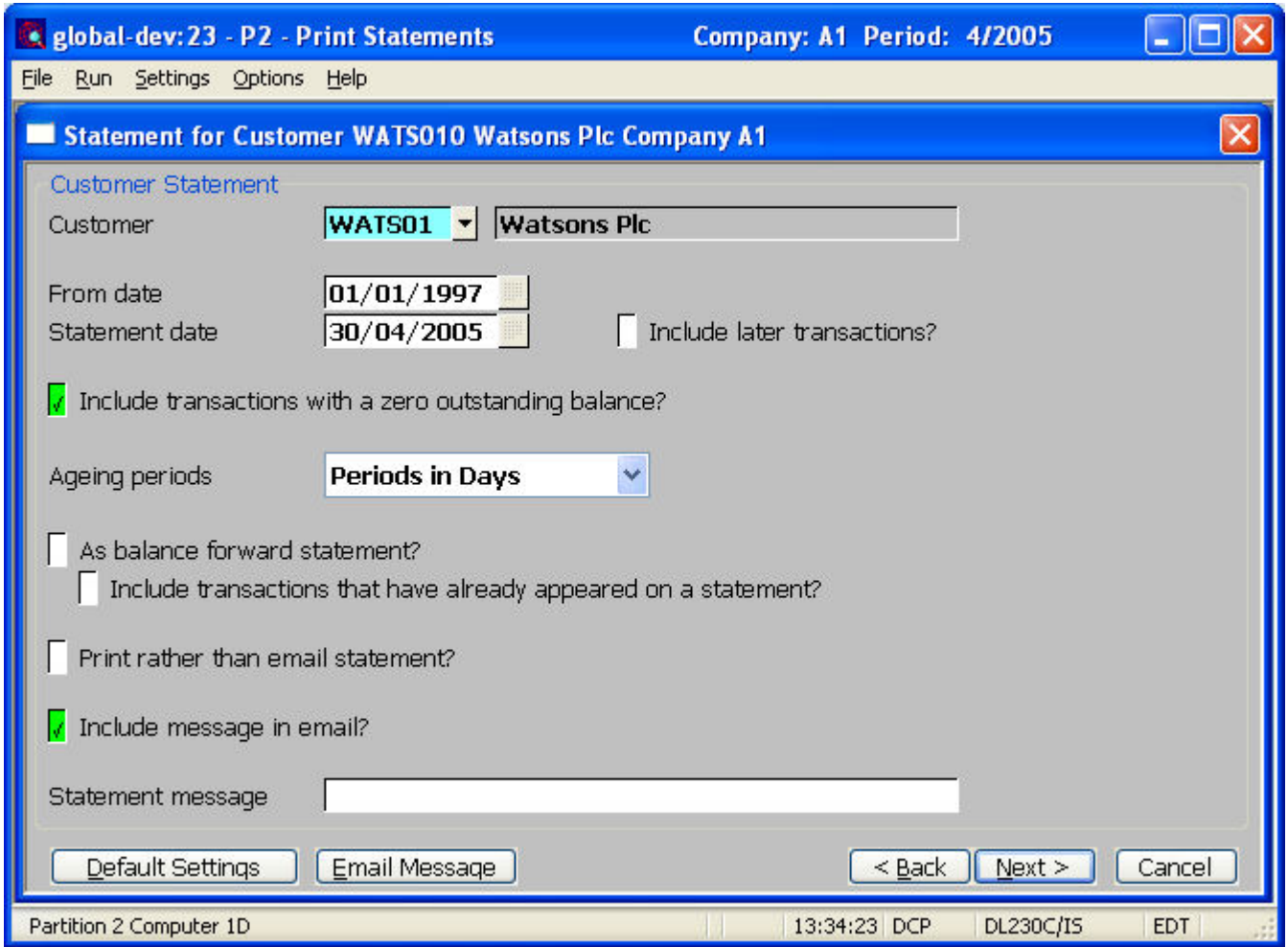

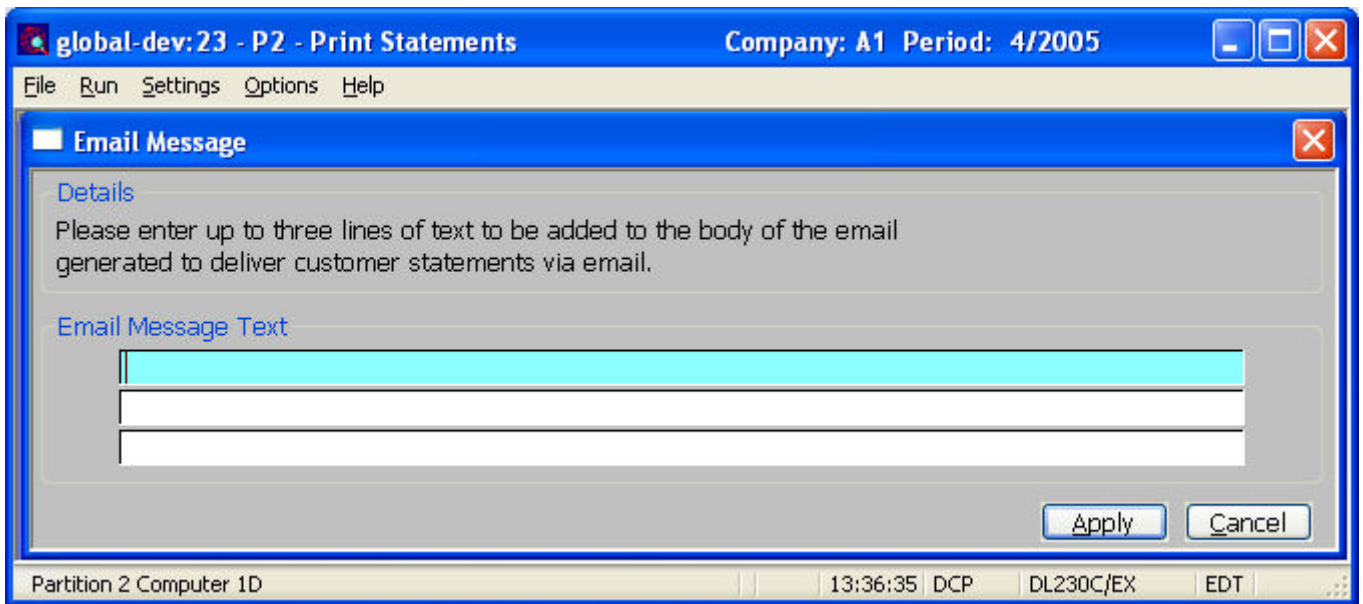
