Standard font	Set this to the font you wish to use for data items that appear on reports and documents produced in PDF format.
Size	Set this to the size (pitch) to be used for the standard font.
Secondary font	Set this to the font you wish to use for column headings etc that appear on reports and documents produced in PDF format.
Size	Set this to the size (pitch) to be used for the secondary font.
Note	The default fonts (Times New Roman and Arial) and sizes (8) are the only fonts supported for use with the standard reports and documents.
Note	In some cases, to successfully fit the report/document on the page a reduced font size is used. In these cases the new font size parameters will not affect the relevant sections of the report/document.
